

# LEADERSHIP Homework

Students have been introduced to the concept of democracy in the context of exploring belonging to groups, rules & laws that affect our daily life, as well as the purpose of local government and the services it provides to the community. In preparation for the next phase of our Civics & Citizenship Inquiry, we ask that students work on the following tasks this week. They can record answers on paper, as a poster or on a google doc/slide.

All questions are to be completed by **Monday the 29th of May.**

1. Describe a group/club/team you belong to. Why do you like belonging to it? How do you contribute to it? Why is it good to belong?
2. Who are leaders in your life that you follow? Give examples and evidence.
3. What qualities and skills do good leaders need to have?  
This can be answered as a thinking web, in dot points or in sentences.
4. Describe ways you think people become a leader.
5. "Leaders have rights and responsibilities."  
Write a response to that statement, including elaborations.
6. Search for leadership quotes. Select one you really like.  
Explain why you chose that quote.

## **Extra Task/s (optional):**

Write a summary about a famous leader you admire **and/or** describe the process for becoming a particular leader (such as the Pope or the Prime Minister).
